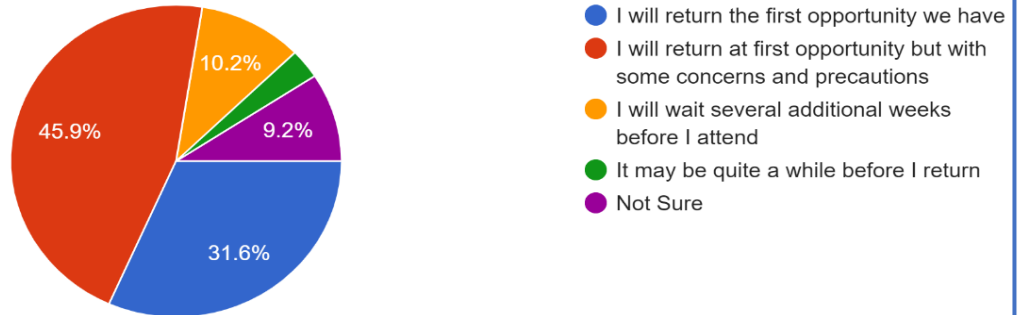


Table 1 -76 of 98 respondents will return right away or return right away with precautions

98 responses

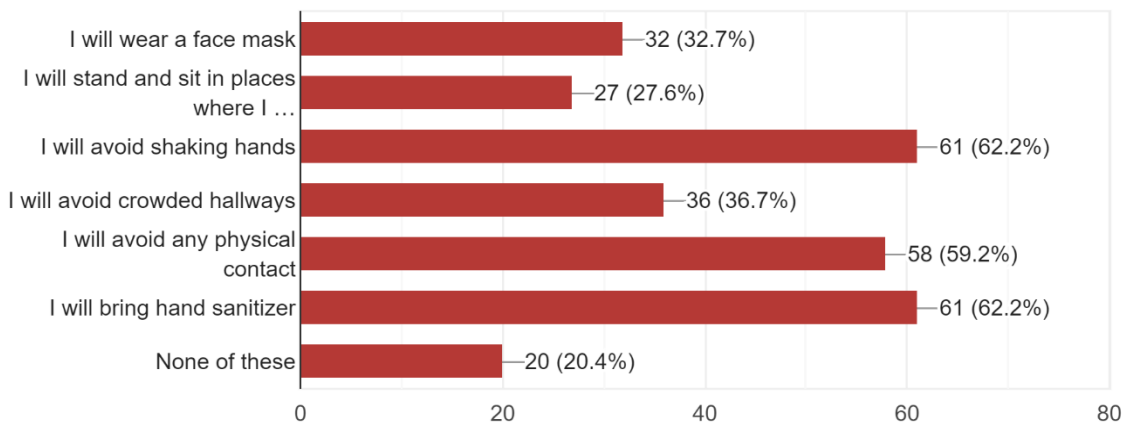

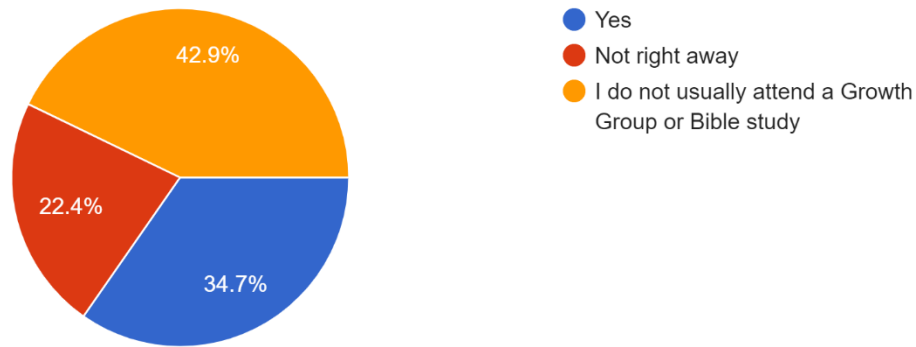
4. What precautions, if any, do you expect our church leadership to take for worship gatherings? Select all that apply

*Note: Discouraging hand shaking, providing hand sanitizer stations, and propping open doors were overwhelmingly the most desired precautions.*

*Table 3: 43% of the respondents (42 of 98) are not involved in a small group and/or bible study.*

Questions 6-8 addressed allowing children to attend Sunday School classes and precautions to take when we do so...

*Note: Over half of parents would let their children attend Sunday School. This would be similar to the precautions we'd take in church, parents desire a clean and sanitized area for their children, as well as proper social distancing.*

9. Which of the following describes the attendance level at which you would be comfortable attending a worship service?

*Note: 88% of respondents would prefer attending with a half-full sanctuary or more. While just over 10% would wait to come back and/or they chose "none of these".*

10. When our local government lifts its ban or guidance against public gatherings, which of the following would you prefer for our church?

*Note: A little over half of the members of Trinity BFC desire to return to worship in an incremental way.*

Questions 11.-12. Would you be willing to attend service at a different time? Would you be willing to attend in an overflow room?

*Note: Both questions were answered overwhelmingly yes.*
